SCHOOL POLICY REMINDERS

Cell Phone Policy: Keep in mind that our school has a policy of NO cell phones or electronics. If confiscated, the parent must come to the office to retrieve it and pay a \$15 fee. All collected fees are applied to our generous scholarship account. **Dismissal:** Please ensure you pick up your students on time. A grace period of 30 minutes will be given to ensure all students are picked up. After the 30 minutes grace period, a fee of \$15 will be charged. Attendance directly affects your child's academic performance. Students arriving after 7:45 a.m. are considered tardy.
