Communication: Please request a parent-teacher conference if you have any concerns regarding the academic progress of your child. We strongly suggest that you not wait until mid-year or the end of the year to share your concerns. HGA is an open-door policy school, so we welcome all parents! HGA values its volunteers, but for the safety and well-being of students please report to the main office to sign in and be issued a guest pass. It is crucial to remain in close contact with your child's teacher throughout the year. Attendance: Regular school attendance is a key factor in student success. It is just as important that students arrive to school on time. The students are expected to be in their desks ready to learn promptly at 7:45 a.m.

Dismissal: Your patience and cooperation is requested during the dismissal process. As an increased safety measure and an effort to reduce wait time in the student pick-up area, the yellow laminated tag should be placed visibly in the vehicle while in the car line, parents are not allowed to enter through the front entrance doors during dismissal, and parents are to form a line near the student pick-up area at the rear of the building and an assigned staff member will alert the students by calling his/her name.

ASP (After School Program): The ASP begins on Wednesday, August 24th and the hours will extend to 5:00 p.m. Monday through Thursday. The Friday schedule will remain from 7:45 a.m. until 2:30 p.m.
